Twice commissioned by the United Nations, the Vatican, and most recently with a 4M tall sculpture commissioned by the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics, Yuroz is an architect by training, an artist by calling, a philanthropist at heart, and the artist of people.

**Visual Poetry You Wear** is the artist's invitation to collectors to interact with his work kinesthetically through touch, as he extends the narratives and captivating visuals of his select original paintings to new luxury scarf designs to adorn collectors in their self-expression and for them to adorn whom they hold dear. These scarfs are made with 100% mulberry silk, hand-rolled with 18 mm silk twill and are printed on both sides. Offered in 3 sizes, 55", 42" and 35" squares, Visual Poetry You Wear is designed to offer distinction, versatility and flexibility to today's wardrobe.

Beginning with "Bliss", original oil on canvas 63" x 49", circa 2010, this cubist composition is laced with impressionist-like brushstrokes, as if the artist was playing music with his paintbrushes.

In this representation, Yuroz unveils two lovers in a portrait of safety, love, and hopefulness as they sit in tandem to soak up the sun's embrace and connect with life's vivacity, putting the artist's love of life and playfulness on full display.














































"Pulse of the Roses" Green, Comp 04, Oil on Canvas, 48" x 48", circa 2016














































"Sofia" oil on canvas, 24" x 20" circa 2001

"Sofia" is a Yuroz original oil on canvas, 24" x 20", circa 2001, portraying a woman with a long neckline symbolizing elegance and grace. His impressionist-like brush strokes contrast the warm yellow with the cold blue palette, complementing the symbolism of the rose representation in Sofia's head. Rose means love, and blue is the color of healing.
